### **Finance Report through June 27, 2011**

Our monthly operating budget for the church is \$15,000. The operating budget pays the basic expenses to keep Sharon Church operating. These expenses include but are not limited to, utilities, landscape, janitorial services, subsidies to PAA and PAES, church administration, etc.

Through June 27, our **expenses have averaged \$15,145 a month** and **contributions to Combined Budget have averaged \$14,927 a month**. Our **expenses have exceeded our contributions** on an average of \$218 a month, for a total of \$1308. This means, if this trend continues, at the end of the year, we will **overspend our budget by \$2,616**.

As you can see additional monies are needed to keep our church fiscally sound. In addition over the next several months there are needed repairs and improvements that need to be made. These include covering the car port ceiling, replacing the parking lot fence, replacing exterior doors, installing an intrusion alarm, repairing outside gutters, parking lot resurfacing, painting both inside and outside. The Church would also like to eventually remodel the kitchen and upstairs/downstairs bathrooms and obtain Audio/Visual equipment to enhance our worship services.

We ask that you please consider increasing your contribution to Combined Budget to help pay our operating expenses. In addition, please consider contributing to the church Building Fund. Monies donated to the Building Fund will be used strictly to pay for improvements/repairs.

If you have questions please feel free to contact Head Elder Troy Price or Finance Chair Brother Derrick Foxworth. May God continue to bless you as you give back a portion of what He has bestowed on you.
