### FINANCIAL EXPLANATION

**Funds** - These monies are sent directly to the Oregon Conference to primarily support the preaching, pastoral, evangelistic work of ministers/Bible teachers. In addition, because Adventist schools are an ongoing ministry to students, tithe funds are used to subsidize selected administrative salaries and a percentage of salaries for teachers. Tithe provides for the support of local, union, division & General Conference services. Tithe is not used to purchase property, build churches or fund the general operations of churches or schools.

**Local Combined Church Budget (Offerings)** - These monies are used to help support our Children, Youth and Young Adults pursuing Christian Education and Sabbath School Ministries. Also supports local church ministries to include Women's, Health, Prison, Fellowship, Outreach, Music, and Benevolence Assistance as well as the ongoing church upkeep & maintenance. We are now in the process of renovating our Kitchen.

### Church at Study - Sanctuary

**Lesson Memory Text:** "Do not weep. Behold, the Lion of the tribe of Judah, the Root of David, has prevailed to open the scroll and to loose its seven seals" ([Revelation 5:5, NKJV](#)).

**Thought to Ponder:** Last week, we looked at Christ's messages to His people on earth. Now John's vision shifts from earth to heaven and focuses on the "things which must take place after this" ([Rev. 4:1, NKJV](#)) - the future. The vision of chapters 4 and 5 takes places in heaven's throne room. The scene of chapters 4 and 5 symbolically portrays God's control of history and of the plan of salvation. Before the future is revealed, however, we are shown the centrality of Christ's high-priestly ministry in heaven to His sovereignty over the affairs of the earth and to His redemption of the human race. In such a way, chapters 4 and 5 provide Heaven's perspective on the meaning of future events recorded in the rest of the book.
