Lesson Memory Text: ““And because of all this, we make a sure covenant and write it; our leaders, our Levites, and our priests seal it’. ... we will not neglect the house of our God” ([Nehemiah 9:38](#); [10:39](#), NKJV).

Thought to Ponder: What does the Bible mean when it talks about the “covenant”? The easiest explanation of this kind of biblical covenant is that it is the legal establishment of a relationship between God and His people. It is God saying, “You are my people, and I am your God”. Beyond this, we can find the use of written covenants among other people in the ancient world, often between leaders and the vassals under them This week, we looked at the covenant that the Israelites renewed with God, in Nehemiah 10, and also discuss some general information about the history and importance of covenant making in the Bible.


