Lesson Memory Text: “And they sang responsively, praising and giving thanks to the LORD: ‘For He is good, for His mercy endures forever toward Israel’ ” ([Ezra 3:11, NKJV](#)).

Thought to Ponder: This week’s memory text gave us insight into the Hebrews’ worship practices and how their gratitude toward God had overflowed in praise to Him. In 515 B.C. they celebrated the dedication of the new temple ([Ezra 6:15-18](#)) and then, about 60 years later, the people celebrated the dedication of Jerusalem’s completed wall ([Neh. 6:15-7:3; 12:27 onward](#)). Such a dedication was thoughtfully prepared and was accompanied with singing, music, feasting, sacrifices, rejoicing, merriment, and the purification of the people. This week we looked at how they worshiped the Lord during this time and see things that we, who worship the same Lord, can apply to ourselves.
